
MODERN AND CONTEMPORARY ART

The modern and contemporary art session of the sale is curated with a special theme—'Contemporary Literati'. 'Literati' refers to ancient Oriental scholars and intellectuals who saw various forms of creative expressions as a way of life. The current theme sale of 'Contemporary Literati' comprises of works by contemporary artists who express the spirit and value of the traditional literati by modern mediums such as photography, sculpture, video, oil or mixed media, as well as artists who express contemporary subject matters by traditional tools such as ink and brush. This special theme 'Contemporary Literati' presents a provoking fusion of the traditional and the contemporary, which may inspire viewers to evaluate the relationship between art and life nowadays.

Yang Yongliang (China, Shanghai B.1980) Horse Training Ink-jet print 2011 220 x 100cm

Yang captured the images of a horse and a man from contemporary life by a camera, and assembled them into a setting inspired by Zhao Mengfu's (1254–1322) famous classical painting from the Yuan Dynasty (1271-1368). The combination between contemporary medium and traditional subject matter creates an intercrossing of time and space, the past and the present.

Dong depicted lotus, one of the most popular subject matters in traditional Chinese ink and brush paintings by modern etching technique on sheet metal. Lines eroded on the metal surface exemplify the power of traditional brush strokes.



JEWELS AND JADEITE

The jewels and jadeite section offers a selection of over a hundred lots of flawless white and coloured diamonds, gemstones, quality jadeite jewels, as well as vintage pieces by international brands.

FLAWLESS DIAMONDS

Among a selection of quality white diamonds is a 17.8-carat pear-shaped diamond, certified as D-colour internally flawless (DIF) by GIA. It is estimated at HK\$24,600,000 to HK\$28,600,000.



FINE JADEITE

Highlight the stunning selection of quality jadeite is a Burmese jadeite pendant set with two intense emerald green jadeite with high translucency. The two pieces of jadeite are delicately carved into sugarloaf shape which could best present their exceptional thickness. The pendant is estimated at HK\$5,000,000 to HK\$6,800,000.
