Jadeite and Diamond Ring

Having a desirable size, the oval-shaped jadeite cabochon is perfect for ceremonial occasions. The massive cabochon radiates a saturated green hue within a sturdy thickness, which is a rare found nowadays. Ms. Tseng has collected a vast array of

refined jadeite and this cabochon had been mounted onto a lavishly designed ring for her show in the 1990s. After being redesigned in recent years, this unsurpassed jadeite and diamond ring has become one of Tseng's favourites.

Fine Jadeite Bangle

Estimate: HK\$ 1,500,000 - 2,500,000 / US\$190,000-320,000

This jadeite bangle is meticulously carved with astonishing thickness and impressive translucency. In the 1990s, Ms. Tseng was renowned in both Hong Kong and Taiwan as the singer of the popular movie *The Dull-Ice Flower's* theme song. Suffused with green patches and streaks, the bangle awakens the reminiscence of Tseng. She bought this bangle as a reward for herself which now becomes one of her treasures.

6.21-Carat Natural Columbian Emerald and Diamond Ring

Estimate : HK\$ 780,000 - 1,000,000 / US\$100,000 - 128,000

Emeralds from renowned Columbian mines have long been praised as the 'King of Emerald'. Weighing 6.21 carats, this sizeable emerald is set to catch everyone's attention with its vivid and captivating green hue. Adorned by pear-shaped and brilliant-cut diamonds together weighing 2.10 carats, this thoughtful design of Ms. Tseng and the jewellery company glorifies the resplendent beauty of the emerald.



Diamond and Gem-set 'Butterfly' Ring; and Pair of Matching Earrings

Diamonds altogether weighing approximately 2.40 carats, emeralds and rubies altogether weighing approximately 1.90 carats

This lot comprises three items. Three glamourous butterflies are gracefully embellished by white diamonds and emeralds. The glittering jewels will certainly make the wearer feel the vivaciousness of

the butterflies. Jewellery suite was particularly sought-after in the 1980s and 1990s. This diamond and gem-set ring and matching earrings were bought to match with one of Tseng's stage costumes.

Oval ruby weighing approximately 1.30 carats, marquise-shaped sapphire weighing approximately 1.00 carats, diamonds and sapphires weighing approximately 3.50 & 2.00 carats respectively

Whimsical design is precisely demonstrated by these brooches. The sapphire brooch, which was a gift from a concert host to Tseng, conveys a strong Art-Deco tone. The middle sapphire resembles Tseng performing on the stage, glowing like the 'diva of the stage'. As for the ruby brooch, the intricate patterns

are all hand-made with 18 karat gold lace openwork, which is rarely seen in recent creations. Both brooches are truly precious treasures not to be missed.





Jadeite and Diamond Ring

Whilst boasting an arresting sheen, the jadeite cabochon is beautifully complemented by the dazzling diamond surround, making it an impeccable example of jadeite excellence suitable both as an accessory and for collection. Attractively-priced, this ring will undoubtedly ignite aggressive bids amongst connoisseurs.

Sapphire and Diamond 'Cross' Pendent Necklace; and Diamond 'Heart' Pendent Necklace

Sapphires and diamonds weighing approximately 2.00 and 3.00 carats respectively

Estimate : HK\$40,000 - 60,000 / US\$5,200 - 7,700

The eye-catching sapphires echo with the glittering diamonds, defining grandeur with style and chic. The 'heart' pendant exudes elegance with its classic yet charming design, representing the grace of love cherished all over the world. Both carrying joyful memories, these majestic treasures were acquired by Ms. Tseng in the US while she was on a performing tour.





Pair of Unmounted Jadeite 'Phoenix' Pendants

Phoenix is known for symbolizing privilege, good fortune and reborn for centuries. Amongst Tseng's jadeite collection, this pair of pendants is the most delicate as the flight-taking phoenix is delineated. The preeminence of the jadeites is enhanced by it high lucidity. Together with the excellence in craftsmanship of the 1970's, these art pieces represent Tseng's prominent achievement in her performing career for more than 40 years.
