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TIANCHENG INTERNATIONAL JEWELLERY AND JADEITE MID-SEASON AUCTION TO TAKE PLACE ON 2 OCT

In response to the increasing demand for designer jewellery and unique works, the auction will highlight an impressive array of refined design pieces. Among them are a charming "Prince Frog" Pendant as well as a Blue Titanium "Butterfly" Brooch by Thai designer Nisan. Both commissioned by Tiancheng International, these delicate designs are one-of-a-kind works that took half a year to complete. Also anticipated is an Emerald Demi-parure by de GRISOGONO. Set with 139.41 carats of natural Colombian emerald of striking colour and approximately 64.00 carats of sparkling diamonds, it promises to be a head turner.

Blue Titanium, Coloured Sapphire and Diamond "Butterfly" Brooch, Nisan

Estimate: HK\$ 80,000 - 150,000 / US\$ 10,300 - 19,200

Tiancheng International has presented a number of extraordinary pieces in collaboration with Thai jewellery designer Nisan, including a Titanium, Sapphire and Diamond "Butterfly" brooch that was sold four times its pre-sale estimate at Autumn Auction 2016. This season another bejewelled "butterfly" by Nisan will be on offer. Tempered under forging temperature, the enthralling blue titanium wings are set with

approximately 27.35 carats of coloured sapphires and approximately 2.55 carats of diamonds. This splendid butterfly is set to dazzle as it flutters by.

Another brainchild of Nisan, this fascinating hummingbird brooch captures with colourful gemstones the intricate movement of the world's smallest bird hovering in mid-air. The brilliance of the sparkly feathers is accentuated by the tanzanite suspending from the beak, adding a playful touch to the piece.





Amethyst, Tsavorite Garnet and Diamond "Prince Frog" Pendant Estimate: HK\$ 78,000 – 120,000 / US\$ 10,000 – 15,400

Commissioned works by Tiancheng International have been extremely sought-after by collectors worldwide. Apart from the aforementioned pieces by designer brands, the sale will also feature an amusing "Prince Frog" Pendant. Adorned with approximately 14.05 carats of tsavorite garnet, holding an intense purple amethyst of approximately 23.05 carats and wearing a crown that forms the loop of a chain, this adorable little creature of genius design is doubtlessly a conversation starter.

Hong Kong-based jewellery designer Jason Koo is known for his distinctive and contemporary designs incorporating elements of nature. This Jadeite, Ruby and Diamond Ring to be offered centres on an impressive jadeite cabochon measuring 21.73 \times 18.10 \times 9.48 mm, emanating an evenly intense green hue. Unlike most jadeite cabochons on the market that are polished to a perfect curvature only on the top, this rare cabochon boasts an elegantly rounded surface on the bottom. The superlative glowing green hue is



beautifully highlighted by the rubies, while the clean and simple design renders the piece an epitome of sophistication.

Icy Jadeite, Jadeite and Diamond "The Love Key" Pendant, OLI

Over the years, Taiwanese jewellery brand OLI exhibits mastery of metal craftsmanship, upholding the spirit of designing jewellery that is easily wearable. In the present piece, the luscious green jadeite is paired with an icy jadeite of limpid translucency, highlighting the outstanding metalwork to create "The Love Key" pendant. Through its impeccable craftsmanship, the brand transforms the essentially traditional jadeite into an alluring design that is suitable for everyday wear, testifying the brand's motto to create designs for people.
